Freeze a moment in time with your family. This is a picture-frame worthy piece of art, or you can even apply this to a piece of cling vinyl and display it on the rear window of the family vehicle.

Materials:

- different colours of paper
- scissors
- glue
- pencil



- 1. Have each family member trace their hand on different coloured papers
- 2. Cut out the hands
- 3. Glue the hands down onto your canvas, starting with the largest at the bottom and smallest at the top
- 4. Consider recording the date, names and something special about the time you and your family got to spend together

Alternate activities:

- For older children, ask them to help cut out the hands is a great fine motor activity.
- Ask your child about what their favourite memory was
- Ask your child which hand is bigger and which is smaller, have them order the hands biggest to smallest
- You can also use the hand cut outs as shadows and have them match the shadows to hands
